August Program Presented by our own John Budree

John began his power point presentation on Paphiopediliums or slipper orchids by telling us that Paphs were one of the first orchids to be grown and bred. Modern day Paphs come in a wide variety of colors excepting blue from their spectrum.

These are terrestrial or semi terrestrial orchids normally growing on

pockets of humus. They are found mainly in the far east from Thailand to Malaysia. They will grow well in Florida and the preferred container for Paphs is a plastic pot since plastic will hold the moisture longer than clay. These plant should be planted in a mixture that will retain moisture since the plant does not like to dry out due to the fine hairs on the root system. John likes to use a mixture of Rexius fir bark, charcoal, Hydratone (which is an expanded clay used in hydroponics) and tree fern fiber. Paphs need to be place where they will receive good indirect light and plenty of air. He advises that Paphs be fed with diluted fertilizer. He likes Captan or Physan as a fungicide, and Cygon or Acephate as a systemic insecticide. He also uses Volck oil for a spray to kill insects but it must be used in the evening or early morning. Superthrive is a great vitamin for the plants. John uses 1 drop Superthrive to a gallon of water.

Our September Speaker, Dr. Rubin P. Sauleda

Dr. Ruben P. Sauleda began growing orchids at the age of 12. At the age of 16 he established Ruben In Orchids. Almost half a century later Ruben In Orchids is recognized internationally and is the oldest orchid business in Florida.

After graduating from Miami Senior High School, he attended Miami-Dade Junior College where he received an Associate of Arts. He was the first biology student in the first graduating class to receive a Bachelor of Science at Florida International University. He was then accepted to Florida Atlantic University where he received an Master of Science in biology working on the orchids of the Bahama Islands. During this time he was asked by Dr. Donovan S. Correll to collaborate on the Flora of the Bahamas by contributing the treatment of the orchids. After graduat-

ing from FAU, he was accepted to the University of South Florida, where he received his Ph.D. in Orchid Taxonomy. He has held positions as a Research Associate at Fairchild Tropical Gardens, Florida Atlantic University, the University of South Florida and several other research institutions. He has taught classes at Florida international University and Miami-Dade Junior College.

Dr. Sauleda has written several books on orchid culture and has written over a hundred articles in scientific journals. He was Chairman of Education for the 2008 World Orchid Conference in Miami. His was responsible for arranging all the lectures, overseeing all the photography and was the editor of the proceedings. His speciality is flasking and is presently the leader in reproducing Encyclia, Cattleya, Schomburgia and Tolumnia species and hybrids. Reuben will be bringing some of his beautiful plants to sell at our meeting. 
