OUR FEBRUARY SPEAKER Alex Lamazares "The Orchid Doctor" from OrchidMania

Alex Lamazares aka "The Orchid Doctor" will be operating at our February meeting. We last had Alex in March 2012. He was funny entertaining and informative. All our members enjoyed his visit.

Donated by Fairchild Tropical Garden, OrchidMania's 3,600 sq. ft. greenhouse facility is where Alex houses the plants that are donated throughout the

year. This is also home to their permanent collection of rare and endangered species that have been donated by growers from all over the world. Alex Lamazares, known as The Orchid Doctor, has been the president of the organization since 1997. He is considered a respected authority amongst his peers for his no-nonsense approach to growing and caring for orchids. He delivers orchid workshops and presentations at orchid clubs and private homes, all over the state of Florida throughout the year. His latest achievement was to be invited to give a talk on orchid care and repotting at the 2008 World Orchid Congress held in Miami, Florida.

Some facts about OrchidMania are: The primary mission of OrchidMania South Florida is to provide financial and moral support to grassroots AIDS prevention and relief organizations, without discriminating on the basis of race, religion, age, national origin, sex, sexual preference, or physical handicap. January Program Was Presented by Dan Christensen from Dan & Margie Orchids

Our January speaker was Dan Christensen, a local grower who specializes in Vandas and Mini cats. With a cold front approaching, Dan gave us some tips on getting our orchids ready. He said that Vanda's are especially sensitive to the cold so it's important to keep the wind off them. So make sure they are protected on the north and west sides. He recommends watering two days ahead of the cold weather. It's important to keep water off of the plants---but the area under them can be watered to raise the air temperature a couple of degrees.

Dan reported that all Vandas, Ascocendas, Aerides and Rhynchostylis will now be called Vandas.

Dan spoke about the 5 elements that orchids require---sun, air, water, medium and fertilizer. Vandas can handle the most sun with Cattleyas next. Cattleyas require a lot of sun to bloom

properly---they may even burn. Mini cats, Oncidiums, and Dendrobiums are next in requirements with Phalaenopsis needing the least. Air movement is vital to orchids as it helps prevent bugs and fungus. It's best to run a fan if orchids are in an enclosure. Watering depends on the type of medium you use. Dan waters his Vandas every other day and everything else once a week. Oncidiums like to be dry. Dan warned us to check the plants purchased at shows. Growers put the plants in sphagnum for their convenience but they should be repotted very soon. Dan recommends no medium for Vandas as that usually just causes problems. Dan uses a mixture of 25% Aliflor, 25% bark, 25% charcoal and 25% medium sponge rock for his Cats. This mix only requires repotting every 2 years. Dan recommends fertilizing weekly, weakly year round.

Dan stated that his love for Mini cats, (Slc's) comes from that fact that they stay small, they bloom 2 - 4 times per year, they require less light to bloom than large Cats. and they have more flowers.

Tony noted that mini cats are good "window sill" orchids as they can be grown inside very successfully. You can reach **Dan and Margie Orchids 18700 S. W. 69th St. Ft. Lauderdale, Florida 333332**
